## LANGUAGE LABORATORY

### Language Lab Software ETNL

ETNL language software enables the students to master the skills of English languages flawlessly in an interactive way. This software helps the teacher to maintain constant two-way communication with every student independently. It is a boon for the students as it imparts crisp and prolonged practice in learning the nuances of the spoken aspect of a foreign language accurately.

Language is the key factor for expressing ideas, views, emotions etc. It is an effective means to effective leadership and professional growth. English is the most common medium of instruction in the Indian education scenario. Job interviews, without exception, are carried on in English. In this scenario, it is time for the student to get onto the right track of learning language skills effectively.

The Language lab at GITAM helps in enhancing the listening and speaking ability of the students by making them practice the correct stress, intonation and accent. Pronunciation is learnt by imitating the speech the listener hears. Language laboratory provides the budding engineers with an ideal model of spoken English with correct sounds, word stress, sentence stress and intonation.

The Language Lab has the ETNL software consisting of 1 teacher's console and 30 students' consoles with 31 high quality headphones. The teacher's console is provided with control functions and the students' consoles are provided with the facility to receive recorded lessons for practice with a view to improvement of pronunciation. The consoles also have the facility to record and replay the students' own production of speech. Thus the students are able to listen to, repeat and compare their pronunciation with the original.
