With reference to your application for Provisional approval for the Master of Planning (Urban and Regional Planning) Course, the Expert Committee visited Ganga Institute of Architecture & Town Planning, Jhajjar, Haryana, on 16th June, 2026. Based on the report of Expert Committee, I am pleased to inform you that the Council of ITPI, in its meeting held on 25th July, 2026, has decided to grant provisional approval for the academic year 2027-28. Approval of this course shall make only the students admitted in the 2027-28 batch (maximum intake of 20 students) eligible for ITPI membership. However you are requested to send compliance on following conditions: -

1. Practicing Urban Planners are to be invited as visiting faculty for field exposure to students.
2. For field projects students require exposure of planning practices in other States. It is expected that the school will make all efforts to maintain good standard of planning education by arranging studio exercise outside the state also, for better exposure.
3. The Institution shall ensure availability of adequate qualified and experienced faculty
4. Students should participate in NOSPLAN regularly.
5. There will be an ITPI nominee in the Board of Governance and Board of studies.
6. As ITPI nominee will be included in the selection committee and as when required.

We kindly request to submit the compliance on the above conditions within a period of one month.
